

# Audience in two groups of 125 arrive from two sides of the circle of the rings to form one audience of 250.

SETTING

- 2 sets of flags/banners pre-set in upright containers (not embedded in ground) on either side of acting area, lit.
- Big banners set on top of hills
- 6 LED Lights set at front weighted down to ensure safe OFF at start
- Other atmospheric lights planted discretely at agreed places on set on.
- INSTRUMENTS SET ON SLOPES (?)
- BOXES to stand on (Clare/Hannah) set at front by rope


## **1 EFFECTS OF WAR**

ACTION: ENTERING ACTING AREA TO FORM V (As Audience Arriving) Cast go to stand – in inverted V - with backs to audience 4 holding staves (to make barn later) JEFF; SHAINE; HELISHA & JACKIE SAM goes to slope at USR


JACK goes to slope at USL

Once audience has arrived : Tony to cue LIGHTS & SOUND RECORDING with a bell


- SFX RECORDED SOUNDSCAPE STARTS\*.
- LX 4-6 Volunteers turn ALL FRONT LIGHTS on simultaneously



ACTION: ACTORS ALL TURN TO FACE AUDIENCE (CUE: WILL / TONY at front - with bell)
 Start, track begins



 During recorded soundscape, one by one, but quickly, ACTORS walk FORWARD to create ONE tableaux <u>'The Civil War in Dorset'.</u>

• They hold positions until just before the narration (Tony's voice) says: 'Clubmen'\*.

#### \*SFX SOUNDSCAPE OF WAR & NARRATION (80 seconds)

**30** secs. RECORDED SFX war – drumming, bugling; horses galloping / clashing swords/ shouting; screaming – leads straight into narration\*

50 secs. \*NARRATION to set scene - on recording

"In 1645 the English Civil War was in its 3<sup>rd</sup> year. Royalist and parliamentarian armies were causing havoc in the Dorset countryside. Press-ganging young men, stealing cattle, destroying crops and burning cottages. All over the West country people opposed to this most horrid and unjust war joined forces. They came to be known as CLUBMEN<sup>\*</sup>. "

ACTION: ALL STAND UPRIGHT, RAISE ARM, AND LOOK AT AUDIENCE, shouting out: "Clubmen" along with the narrative. Then freeze during Tony's final recorded text:

NARRATION In the month of May 4000 of them gathered here at Badbury Rings'. SFX RECORDING OFF

## 2. SEARCHING FOR SAFETY (Chaos! aka pushing & pulling sequence)

## 60 seconds

LIVE DRUM SOLO Live Drummer JACK appears AT TOP USR, moves to drum on stand, begins drum solo

## ACTION (DURING LIVE DRUMMING)

MOTIVATION: Helping; struggling; rescuing; maybe a partner is limping or falling.

FEELING: Scared, angry or determined. Or a bit of each!

## PARTNERS:

LAUREN & IZZY; SANDRA & ALAN; HAYDN & SHEILA; STEWART & EVA & SUE; DAVE & JANE; ANNEMARIE & GILL; JEFF & SHAINE; HELISHA & JACKIE; TUPPY & BARBARA & PIPPA; AMY & CLARE; ANNA & BABY; LUKE & HEATHER. WILL mingling, encouraging from within.

- Decide before which partner is 'A' & who 'B'
- Simultaneously, all hurry to find partners.
- Push or pull them to find safe spaces
- 'A's lead 'B's in one direction then stop suddenly as if an explosion goes off right where you were heading
- 'B' takes over changes direction and leads 'A' off to new possible place of safety.
- Could also be done solo (e.g. WILL)?

NB. explore all acting area as you travel searching for safety. SUB TOTAL 2 mins 20 secs


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## **3. SHELTERING IN THE BARN**


## 60 seconds

JACK improvises drumming to accompany sequence ACTION:


• WILL (points to front (imaginary barn); "Look! Into the barn there!"



- LAUREN "Hurry!" & SHAINE: "Come on!"; GILL points too
- At DSC, close to central lights, JEFF; SHAINE; HELISHA & JACKIE make wooden frame with 4 sticks;



- Others come and stand, lean behind, on either side of the barn
- ANNA & Baby at front in doorway cowering




 Live SFX - STEWART cues start burning of barn – fire - flicking hands, making sounds; slapping; wind sounds, etc. Gradually passes from one to another until ensemble – CACOPHONY! (ie Very loud)




**SUB TOTAL 3 MINS 20 SECS** 

• All crumble away - in different twisted, low poses, but not on ground)




Shelter galls (Crumbled remains) Move to single line cued by SAM on saxophone



## **4. FAMINE**

**1min 6 secs** SAM (standing up – just behind steps on slope : Mournful SAX SOLO ACTION:

- Help each other up
- Move slowly, hungrily, some hobbling, to make line across acting area.
- (CLARE & STEWART at stage left. ANNA is stage right end. EVA & AMY @ stage left
- Tired & Hungry, form lines facing audience



- From one end (St. right) Woman ANNA makes her way along line, asking for food for the baby
- Everyone shakes their head to decline and turns their bacic
- Woman reaches other end and sinks down, desolate


## **5. PRESS GANGING**

(aka Sticky Shapes – all making tunnel)


• Drum roll triggers everyone to move into new tunnel shape

## 1 minute

- ACTION: Actors move quickly frightened again Hands up, touching fingertips on either side.
- DAVE & JANE move away



- (JACK the Drummer descends steps if practicable. Marches along front of line, drumming up support)
- From SL end of line, sisters EDEN (EVA) runs from AMY who calls the name "Eden!" tries to stop them twisting their way through the arches landscape towards centre



- From SR end, Parents STEWART & CLARE hurry along to stop EVA
- EVA as young man reaches out arm to front to go and join army
- AMY tries to hold her back from behind: "Don't go"
- STEWART & CLARE stretch across to stop son forced to fight (e.g., dynamic as in last session – son pushing through, held back) "Unjust war!"
- DAVE with JANE close by, yells 'We demand peace!"
- JANE plays Singing Bowl

## 6. **RESISTANCE – ENTRY OF PAMPHLETEERS** (Additional Choir Members)


• SFX RECORDED Sound of bells – growing louder

## 30 seconds Bell sfx


- ACTORS react as they spot arrival of big banner and singers with leaflets in basket.
- VOICES CALL OUT: Look! / Soldiers? / No, not soldiers' / Who are they? / 'What do they want? /

## ACTION:


• REST OF CHOIR (LYNNE; MIKE; PETE; CHRIS; MATTHEW; SAMMY; JOANNA; LINDA; DI; SUE; JUDITH;) enter through central gap, holding big banner, carrying leaflets in baskets/bags. CHOIR start handing them furtively to WCT singers close by



 SINGING MEMBERS OF WCT ONLY – TUPPY, JEFF; JACKIE; JOANNA, JANE, SAMMY, WILL, LAUREN - take bunches of leaflets & look, then join choir, forming 'clump' centre stage.



NON-SINGING Actors move off from upstage with purpose, forming a semi-circle – listening, facing upstage – some kneeling. Some -e.g., Gill. can be on hill/slopes

## 7. SINGING OF THE "CLUB DECLARATION"

1 min 18 seconds

SOLO "What we believe in is largely forgotten" etc. Then...

Sisters, brothers

What we believe in
is almost forgotten.

Is accounted as the loss of all

We demand

just intentions,
fair provisions.

Compensation,

Reparation!

Song finishes SUB TOTAL 7 minutes 18 seconds


## 8. SPREADING THE WORD

## Interaction with audience / Gathering banners for finale

2 minutes

- SFX Bells louder
- MUSIC SAM Saxophone repeat of song singers may join in/ hum
- CHRIS & FX Volunteers turn lights around to shine on audience for next sequence

**ACTION**: STEWART(A), AMY & EVA (B); JEFF (A) & SHAINE (B); BARBARA (A), LAUREN & IZZY (B); WILL, HEATHER (A); LUKE (B); JANE (A) & DAVE (B); HAYDN (A) & SHEILA (B) go in pairs along front and beckon to DIFFERENT parts of audience to listen, while handing out leaflets to them.



BOTH: 'Sisters! Brothers! (Hand out pamphlets)

- A: for three years, soldiers of both sides've been rampaging (or trampling) across our land!
- **B: Stealing our horses!**
- A: Burning our barns!
- **B: Destroying our crops!**
- A: Press-ganging our sons to fight in their unjust war!
- B: Aren't you fed up with it?

(Wait for response)

- A: Well, aren't you?
- B: 'Cos we Clubmen are!

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A: So...are you with us?

B: Can't hear you!

A: (Holding up leaflets) It's all written down here! If you want peace, gather together ...


BOTH: at Badbury Rings!

B: to hear our Declaration!

- A: And Sing our song with us the words are on the back of the leaflet!
- B: You may need your lanterns!

## SIMULTANEOUSLY


 CHOIR & REST OF WCT - GILL & ANNEMARIE; PIPPA & TUPPY; HELISHA & JACKIE; CLARE; ANNA go to fetch flags, banners from 2 settings on either side of acting area.



• Towards the end of the speechifying, they go down and hand out flags and banners to singers and cast, saying:

Come on! It's time for The Gathering'!

• Some bravely climb up the steps and onto top - to position themselves with flags against horizon – they raise banners, staves, etc.



#### CUE TO STOP:

• SFX Bells start ringing (Tony to cue Chris) SUB TOTAL 9 mins 18 secs

fx Volunteers turn lights back to face front as before SFX LIVECUE JACK - solo drummer

#### SUB TOTAL 9 mins 33 secs

4. INTO THE FINALE - PROCLAMATION SONG 30 seconds

- All form a BIG Tableaux, spread all over acting area
- HAYDEN ON TOP USR WITH BIG FLAG
- GILL & ANNEMARIE with flags

#### SUB TOTAL 10 mins

SONG 2: ENSEMBLE (waving flags and banners) (marching actions)

#### 1 min 20 seconds

Come parson, come brewer, come brother follow me We need to make a living, take a stand we all agree Four thousand strong we'll march\* as one To defend our rights, to show our might We will overcome, we will overcome! For we come in peace, we mean no harm Stop your plundering of our farms! Stop your varring, vicious ways Give us back our peaceful days! \*With this merry band, we'll preserve our land And you'll not take away our song – So, stop this war, move, move along!

(REPEAT LAST LINES from \*'With this Merry Band') ACTION: RIGHT SIDE move to face right – and the audience) LEFT SIDE move left to face audience ALL FREEZE in big poses

JACK: Final short Live drum solo? <u>TOTAL 11 minutes 30 seconds</u> END
